## Guidelines for restriction of activities in Non Curfew imposed areas

The COVID 19 situation is subject to change from time to time and currently the country is considered as in Alert Level 3.

Utility services – electricity, water, telecommunications, Petrol stations, LP gas stations, motor garages / tyre services and postal/courier services	Provide all essential services with minimum of the staff
Government Offices	With minimum number of staff required. Others to work from home where feasible.
Private sector offices	With minimum number of staff required. Others to work from home where feasible.
Export oriented industries (including	Function within a bio secure bubble (i.e. ensuring secure accommodation

Supermarkets	A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.  (On the basis of - 1.5m <sup>2</sup> of available walking space can be considered as adequate for 1 person
Shopping Malls	1.5m² of available walking space can be considered as adequate for 1 person inside the individual shops. For shops: A maximum of 50% of the total number customers that could be accommodated in the space available can be allowed at a given time adhering to the instructions given.  Gatherings and entertainment in the mall premises are strictly not allowed.
